What types of camping setups are allowed?

We allow almost ANY type of camping rig! Bring your pole tents, teepees, hammocks, vans, truck camper, roof tents, safari/wall tent, and any other thing you can pitch on the ground or in the trees. You are welcome to park your vehicle and/or motorcycle by your setup, just be careful not to set up camp where someone will be blocked in.

What facilities are available to tent campers?

There is a shower house with 3 showers each (with hot water) on the Men's and Women's sides. Both sides have flush toilets and sinks as well. The camping area does not have electricity, but running water can be gotten at the shower house or in the RV park.

Can I run a generator in the camping area?

We have a specific area in the back pasture for folks using generators. Please be courteous of your neighbors and set up so that you don't disturb anyone with your generator. Use caution with generator placement and keep the exhaust clear of each other's campsites and rigs. NO generators in the RV park!

Are campfires OK?

Campfires are allowed when there is no burn ban in place for Rusk County. All campfires must be contained within a ring of some sort. Elevated fire pits are fine but still subject to the county burn ban. Propane fire pits are welcome as well. (*Rusk County issues a ticket of \$500 to anyone violating the burn ban*)

Can I pitch a tent in the RV park?

We now allow tent camping in the RV park for this event ONLY. You must pay for an RV site to pitch a tent in one (*limit 4 tents per site*). All tents and similar type setups must be inside the boundaries of the paid RV site. Any use of adjacent sites (plugging in, using water, setting up partly in the neighboring site) will result in being charged for the extra site(s).

What different areas are available in the camping fields?

Please see the included map for a visual of the different areas. We like to split the different types of setups into zones as to make it easy for folks with similar setups to lay out their camps efficiently. Creating general areas for those with generators, those with truck or van rigs, and those with traditional rustic camping setups makes it simple and safe for everyone to make camp.

Is there a *dump station* for "dry" RV campers?

Yes! Please inquire with someone at the office or near the front gate for help with this. Our staff can direct you to an appropriate place to empty tanks.
